

What is Ausbildung?

Ausbildung is Germany's internationally recognised vocational training system. It combines classroom education with practical work experience inside real companies. Students learn directly within real workplaces while receiving professional training at vocational schools.

Key Features of Ausbildung:

- Duration: 2 – 3.5 years
- Students receive a monthly training allowance up to 1,500 Euros per month
- Combination of theory and practical training
- Nationally recognised German qualification

Many Ausbildung graduates continue working in Germany after completing their training.

German Language Programme at Blue Mountains Academy

Our German Language Programme is designed to develop strong communication skills while preparing students for academic, professional, and everyday life in Germany.

The curriculum follows the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), the internationally recognised standard for language proficiency and is TELC exam focused

Levels Offered:

- **A1** – Beginner
- **A2** – Elementary
- **B1** – Intermediate

Each level focuses on practical communication skills, listening comprehension, grammar development, and real-life conversational ability.

Flexible Learning Pathways

Students may choose to study German according to their individual goals.

Some students choose to complete A1 or A2 levels to gain basic language skills before travelling to Germany for:

- English-taught university programmes
- Exchange programmes
- Cultural immersion or short-term study

Other students continue to B1 level, which is commonly required for vocational training pathways such as Ausbildung or for further language advancement.

This flexible structure allows students to tailor their learning journey based on their academic or career objectives.

TELC Examination Preparation

Our programme places strong emphasis on preparation for TELC German Language Examinations, which are widely recognised by vocational institutions, employers, immigration authorities, and academic institutions in Germany.

Students undertake internal assessments after each level to evaluate progress and readiness for official examinations.

Pathways Beyond B1

Students who plan to pursue German-taught university degrees at public universities in Germany are typically required to demonstrate advanced language proficiency at C1 level.

After completing B1 TELC level, students may continue their language progression through advanced language studies, private 1-to-1 tuition, and targeted preparation for higher level language certifications.

All programmes are approved by the Ministry of Education Malaysia (MOE).

- Cross-cultural healthcare awareness




Career Preparation & Industry Exposure

Academic Calendar 2026 and Intake Schedule

Programme Intakes & Application Deadlines

To provide students with flexibility and multiple opportunities to begin their German language journey, **Blue Mountains Academy** offers **four intakes each year**.

Students are encouraged to submit their applications early to ensure sufficient time for enrolment processing, document preparation, and study planning.

**Applications received after the official deadline may be considered for the next available intake, subject to seat availability.*

Students at Blue Mountains Academy can choose a study format that fits their schedule while progressing through the German Language Pathway to B1 (TELC) for the Ausbildung program in Germany.

The full pathway from A1 to B1 typically takes about six months of full-time study, though students may also enrol in individual levels based on their goals.

Important Notes for Students

- Students planning to pursue **Ausbildung pathways** are typically required to achieve **B1 German language proficiency**.
- Students intending to enrol in **English-taught university programmes** in Germany may choose to complete **A1 or A2** levels to gain basic communication skills before departure.
- Students aiming to study **German-taught programmes** at public universities may require **C1 level**, and may continue their studies through advanced language training after **completing B1**.

Early Application Recommended

As class sizes are kept intentionally small to ensure quality instruction, early application is strongly **recommended**.

Applying early also allows students to:

- Secure their preferred intake
- Plan their study progression more effectively
- Begin preparing documentation for future study or training opportunities in Germany

Students are encouraged to apply early to secure placement in their preferred intake.
